1. Introduction

2. What Data Do We Collect?

The Company may collect, process, and store the following categories of personal data:

2.1 Identification Data

- Full name;
- Username or other system identifier;
- Date and place of birth;
- Gender;
- Citizenship and country of residence;
- Identity verification (documents, photographs, digital images).

2.2 Contact Information

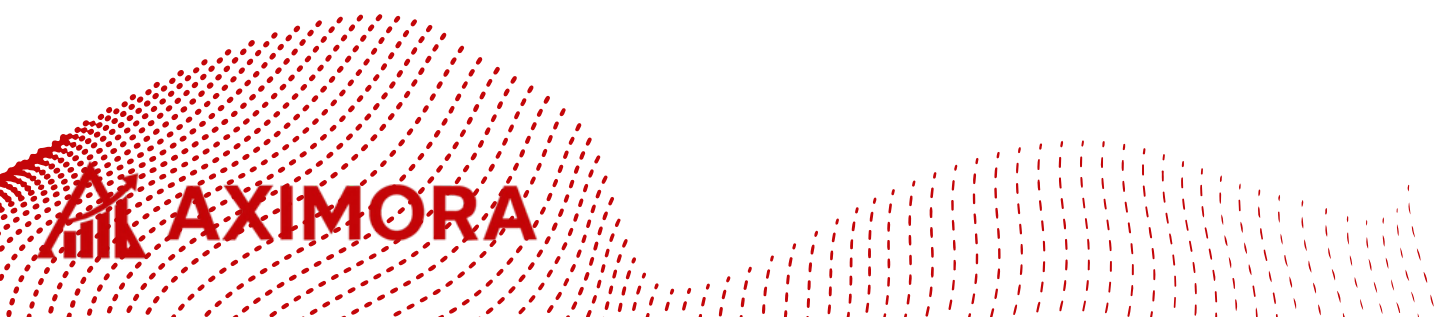
- Actual and/or legal residential address;
- Address verification (scans or images of documents);
- Phone number;
- Email address.

2.3 Professional Information

- Level of education;
- Place of employment and job position;
- Experience in online trading;
- Awareness of the risks associated with trading.

2.4 Financial and Tax Information

- Annual and monthly income;
- Source of funds;
- Tax status, country of tax residence, taxpayer identification number (TIN);
- Bank account details, card numbers, proof of card ownership;
- E-wallet information.



2.5 Technical Information

- IP address and geolocation;
- Browser type and version;
- Operating system and device used to access the services;
- Network connection data.

2.6 Behavioral Data

- Preferences for receiving promotional materials;
- Communication channels (email, phone, messengers);
- Preferred language of communication.

2.7 Marketing Data

- Actions on the website (page views, link clicks, downloads, feedback form submissions, etc.);
- Frequency and duration of visits.

3. Cookie Policy

Cookies are small pieces of data that are stored on your device when you visit our website. They are used to:

- Improve website functionality and user experience;
- Remember user preferences;
- Analyze visitor behavior;
- Personalize content and advertising.

You can manage cookie settings through your browser settings. Disabling cookies may limit the functionality of some of the Company's services.

4. How Do We Use Your Data?

The Company processes personal data strictly for legitimate purposes, including:

- To provide and improve services;
- To comply with legal obligations;
- For marketing and analytical purposes;
- To ensure security and protect client data.

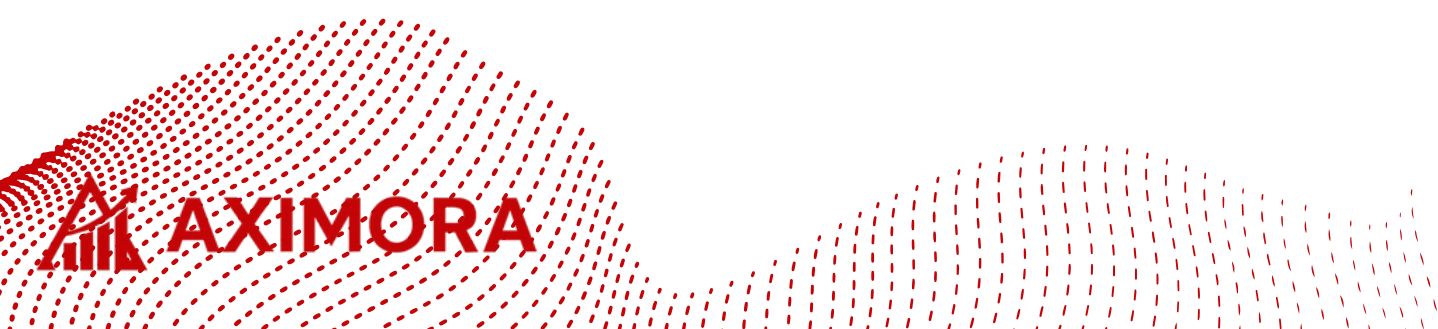
5. Sharing Personal Data with Third Parties
